Lesson Goals:

- Provide multi-modal communication opportunities for learners to communicate for a variety of communicative functions.
- Engage in emergent literacy through shared reading.

Materials Needed:

- Book
- Materials from SENSEable Literacy book box

Learning Objectives:

 Learners will engage within the shared reading and extension activities, using multi-modal communication while learning emergent literacy skills.

Structure / Activity:

- Engage students in shared reading of the book modeling core a fringe vocabulary throughout.
- Make pudding (a.k.a. mud) with students and put into one container.
- Distribute dinosaurs amongst students.
- Encourage students to put dinosaurs into the "mud" and mimic the actions of the dinosaur from the book.
- When finished, have students place dinosaur into a separate container with water to "wash" them.

Assessment:

- Did students initiate communication during shared reading?
- Did students imitate vocabulary modeled during shared reading?
- How did students communicate during the activity?
- How did you feel during the activity?
- What would you change next time?




















Follow the CAR


